

German Course - Intermediate - B2 Preparation for the DSH exam



All the necessary information you need

► Basic information

The goal of this course is that the students are able to understand and work with complex and abstract texts and that they are able to communicate in a fluent, appropriate manner. The students can clarify their position, even in discussions with native German speakers.

► Prerequisites

To attend the course you should at least speak German on B1 level and be willing to study an extra 3 hours by yourself additionally to the course.

► Content

The course is built upon the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. It includes exercises and texts that deal with topics from daily life, work, culture, science and studying at university. We always encourage and help our students to improve their studying skills in general.

► Structure

The course is modular and clearly structured. Each week starts with a new and independent topic which makes it possible to join the course at almost any time. Each unit focuses on the four essential parts – listening, reading, writing and speaking.

The course includes a total of 200 lessons (45 minutes each).

We teach 20 lessons per week (Mon-Fri), beginning in the afternoons.

► Teachers

Our teachers are especially trained for teaching German as a foreign language. They speak German as their mother tongue and are very experienced in working with people from different countries and cultures.

Because of their personal continuous teaching trainings they are always up to date.

► Costs

When you register for the course you have to pay at least 400,-- €. The rest of the tuition fee has to be paid as soon as the course starts. You can pay cash or via bank transfer (Stadtsparkasse Kaiserslautern, IBAN DE17 5405 0110 0000 5638 33).

The books have to be paid as soon as you receive them.

If you want to take part in the exam you will receive a separate invoice for the exam fee.

► Visa

After you have registered for the course and paid the total tuition fee we can send you an official note of registration (Certificate of permission to attend German classes). This document can be handed in when applying for a visa. In case you cannot obtain a visa we will reimburse you for the costs already paid less an administration fee.

► Exam

The course prepares you for all exams, such as Goethe-Zertifikat B2, telc Deutsch B2 and the special exams necessary for university admission in Germany, such as DSH, TestDaF and DSD. At the end of each quarter there will be offered a school-internal written and oral B2 exam in which you are welcomed to take part. After having passed the exam successfully you will receive an official certificate from Sprach- und Wirtschaftsschule Rahn.
